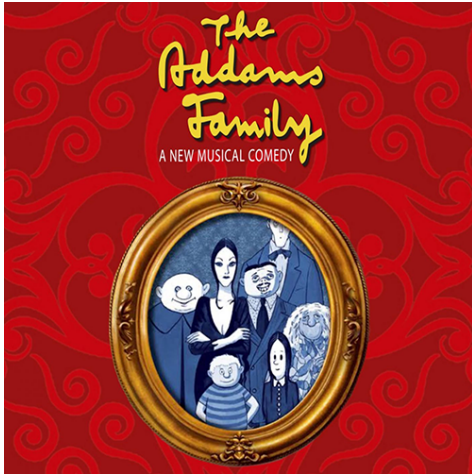

- ☐ Please be advised that students cast in any major roles will be accepting the role and committing to the scheduled rehearsals. This means lead roles may be unable to participate in certain other sports and activities during all musical rehearsals and performances. We want to make sure that students are prepared and successful on stage as well as the field.
- ☐ Each cast member and parent will need to confirm and commit to their involvement.

The final weeks before the performance are dress rehearsals and tech rehearsals. We need everyone onstage to put the final stage blocking, sets, and dances together in our performance space. They are long rehearsals, so please be sure you can commit to the schedule and have rides home at this time. Students should also bring snacks on these days.

Dear Parents and Students Auditioning for the School Musical,

We are ready to kick off our annual school play. This year, we will be working on The Addams Family! We will have a total of 2 performances. One during the school day for Culver staff and students and then an evening performance for parents, families and friends. More information about the performance, including updated safety information, will be provided closer to the performance date.

We request that you review the guidelines and calendar for participating in the play. We ask that you check to be sure that both you and your student have the time available to commit to being involved in such an exciting experience as theater.

The most important aspect of being part of a cast is sharing your time. Each member is vital when it comes to preparing any type of performance. When students are not at rehearsals that impacts the entire show. So, please be sure you can and will commit to rehearsals. If you can't make the rehearsals because of other clubs/activities/sports, maybe this is not the time for you to audition for the musical. **Students who miss more than 3 rehearsals will be subject to recast.**

Commitment to academics is our first priority, so please do not put more pressure on yourself if you are struggling academically. Please let us know if this becomes a problem and we will work to recast you in your role.

*****Please be aware if you are cast in one of the major roles, you will need to commit to our schedule which may conflict with spring sports and activities. You will not be able to be involved in activities that conflict with the musical schedule.*****

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

Culver School promotes the development of a well-rounded student. Culver's eligibility agreement has been created to allow students opportunities for participation within non-academic oriented activities while recognizing that Culver is first and foremost an academic institution. Academics are a student's first priority. Therefore, students are required to meet the requirements listed below in order to participate in any extracurricular activities that take away from the time needed to successfully complete academic responsibilities outside school hours (completing homework and/or major projects, studying for tests, etc.). The criteria used to determine the significance of time is any activity that requires more than one hour of participation per week. Extracurricular activities that require more than one hour of participation per week include Student Council, basketball, cheerleading, chorus, track and the school play. Sponsors, coaches, teachers, and administration will work together to continually monitor the performance of all participants to see that each meets the requirements listed below.

A PARENT MEETING WILL BE HELD DURING CURRICULUM NIGHT FOR PARENTS OF STUDENTS WHO PLAN ON JOINING ONE OF THESE ACTIVITIES

TRYOUTS

- A meeting with the interested students and activity sponsors/coaches will be scheduled three weeks before joining, or trying out for one of the above activities.
- At the initial meeting, sponsors/coaches will distribute "clearance sheets" for students to return to the sponsors/coaches on the Friday prior to the beginning or tryout session of the activity.
- Students interested in joining/trying out for activities beginning October 1st or later will be required to have a cumulative "C" average for the quarter in each subject area on the Friday prior to the start/tryout period of the activity.
- Students must have a physical exam which remains current (within 12 months) during the duration of the activity.
- Students must have a signed permission form from their parents to join/try out for the activity.
- The above mentioned "clearance sheets" will provide the following information to the coaches/sponsors:
 - Teacher verification of Cumulative "C" (2.0) average for each subject area
 - Nurse verification of physical exam remaining current (within 12 months) for duration of activity
 - Signed parent permission

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Students must maintain a cumulative "C" (2.0) average for the quarter, for the duration of the activity.
- Each student's academic status will be determined on the Friday (Thursday in the event there is no school on Friday) of each week. *
- If a student does not meet the academic requirements, he/she will be placed on probation for the following week.
- Students on probation may fully participate in the activity.
- Students may be placed on probation two times for the duration of the activity.
- If a student does not meet the academic requirements by the end of the second probation period, he/she will be removed from the activity.
- Once a student has been on probation two times, he/she must maintain the academic requirements for the duration of the activity. Failure to do so will result in removal from the activity.

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT COUNCIL

Student Council will adhere to the same academic guidelines, but restart at the beginning of the third and fourth quarter.

Example: An officer/member is removed from Student Council for academic ineligibility. The officer/member may return to the activity if they present an academic "clearance sheet" at the beginning of the new quarter.

BEHAVIORAL REQUIREMENTS

- Students are expected to behave properly at all times.
- Students who receive a detention will not be allowed to participate in an activity for two days.
(The day they receive the detention and the following day.)
- Students who receive a total of three detentions during the duration of the activity may be removed from the activity.
- Students who receive a behavioral referral may become ineligible or removed from an activity as determined by administration.
- Students who receive a suspension will be ineligible for two weeks or removed from an activity as determined by administration.
- Students receiving two or more suspensions during the activity will be removed from the activity.

* There will be no eligibility status changes on three day weeks and the 1st week of each quarter. Recognizing that it is difficult for a student to bring up a grade in a three day period, the probation period will be extended during weeks there are two days of no school attendance. A student's eligibility status will remain status quo during those weeks.

The principal may establish guidelines, as appropriate, in lieu of and/or in addition to those listed above.

Culver School Extracurricular Activity Policies

Attendance

Definitions:

Unexcused absence- Failure to attend practice/competition without written note, phone call, email, etc. from a parent or guardian.

Excused absence- Any absence that is accompanied with a written note, phone call, email, etc. that same day or the next day to notify the sponsor.

1st unexcused absence- no penalty, written notice sent home.

2nd unexcused absence- attendance at next competition (game/meet) without participation, written notice sent home.

3rd unexcused absence- dismissal from activity, written notice sent home.

* Chronic absences, *both excused and unexcused*, may be reviewed by the sponsor and administration on a case-by-case basis if it is determined that the absences are affecting the activity.

Behavior

Major ODR/ Detention

- Two (2) days of non-participation from activity, although attendance is required.

Suspension

1st- Two (2) weeks of non-participation from activity (or administrative decision).

2nd- Dismissal from activity.

Student Pick-Up After Activity

At the conclusion of the activity (practice/game) students should be picked up in a timely manner. Students should be picked up no later than fifteen (15) minutes after the activity is concluded. Please refer to the schedule that has been sent home with your child by the coach/sponsor. Parents/guardians will also receive a permission slip to notify the coach/sponsor that their child may either walk home or be picked up by car only. Also, please note if your child may have permission to walk to the library or fitness center on that permission slip.
