CBM Benchmark Assessments

Benchmark assessments will begin the week of January 8th for grades 6-8 students and the week of January 16th for students in grades K-5. Students will be administered Curriculum Based Measurements (CBMs) in reading and math. This information helps to determine placement into or exit from intervention as well as helps inform the teacher of differentiation needs in the classroom.

ACCESS Testing for English Learning Students

Students in kindergarten through eighth grade who are identified as English Learners will begin taking the ACCESS test, an English language proficiency assessment, in mid-January. All assessments will be completed in February.

Morning Arrival

As always, it's ideal to bring your children to school early so they can enjoy breakfast, starting at 7:40. During the winter months, we will open our doors at 7:50 each morning to allow students to remain warm until the 7:55 bell.

And a reminder, please pull all the way up when dropping off or picking up your child. Please do not park in the drive thru area; this is not part of the parking lot. It is a thoroughfare. Also, when you exit the front lot, you can only turn right. Turning left causes major delays and is not the safest route.

Student Cell Phone Use

Students know their cell phones should be in lockers and turned off during school hours. It becomes challenging when students are texting parents and vice versa, as the office staff is not able to keep track of visitors and student needs. This can become a safety concern. This is particularly difficult if your child is sick and texts you rather than going through our school nurse. If your children need to reach out to you, they can use our school phone; this is an easy way for students to connect with home.
