- a. ALICE Training: All returning staff to complete the ALICE refresher training and new staff to complete the entire course.
 - b. It is recommended that the safety consultants come back and meet with the staff.
 - c. Discussion about encouraging teachers to teach with doors closed with the goal of getting to the point of teaching with doors locked.
 - d. During the next lock down drill, communicate with students options of what to do if they are not in the classroom when there is a lockdown.
 - e. Discussed the contents of the emergency backpacks. Water has also been placed in the classrooms. Mental health items can be added to the backpacks.
 - f. Safety film is already in place in all of our entrance doors.
 - g. Maintenance department is in the process of enhancing outside signs.
 - h. Reverse playground evacuation will be scheduled with a couple other safety manual procedures to provide some training to staff.

 1. The school crisis response plan was updated this summer with the support of safety consultants hired by the district.

 1. We will consult with law enforcement and safety consultants about the decorative window clings.
